The letter **P** is used for **P**resent, **P**assive, **P**articiple, and **P**lural

The letter **F** is used for **F**uture, and **F**eminine

The letter **S** is used for **S**ubjunctive and **S**ingular

The letter **O** is used for passive dep**O**nent and **O**ptative.

The multiple use of the same letter for different parsing items enables us to keep the code as short as possible. Only single letters are used. The meanings of the letters are determined by position in the Code.

Dodson informs us, “Note that the English definitions are not adjusted according to context, and no interpretive decisions are made for the reader. Each definition may contain a range of meanings, so the particular meaning should be determined by examining the surrounding context.” This is different from most reader’s editions, which give only the meaning of the word in the context and exclude other possibilities.
